**PERSONAL CHOICE DINING**

***Traditional Fixed Seating***

Dine in the Regency Dining Room each night, according to your pre-assigned seating arrangement as follows:

<i>Second Seating</i>	8:15pm

***Anytime Dining***

Dine anytime in our alternative Marquis Dining Room between 5:30pm and 10:00pm. If there is an exact time you wish to dine or if you wish to dine with friends, then please call our "Dine Line" (extension 3463) to make a reservation. Otherwise, please make your way directly to the Marquis Dining Room, where the Maitre D' will make every effort to accommodate your request, based on availability.

**DISCRETIONARY HOTEL AND DINING CHARGE**

During your cruise, you will meet many members of our staff in a variety of locations as they provide you with excellent service. Additionally, many more crew behind the scenes support those who serve you directly. For your convenience a discretionary Hotel and Dining charge of \$10 per passenger per day (including children) will be automatically added to your shipboard account on a daily basis. The Hotel and Dining charge will be shared amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the wait staff, stateroom stewards and accommodations staff, buffet stewards, galley staff, laundry staff and others. Please note this is a discretionary charge and should you wish to make any adjustments, you may do so by contacting the Passenger Services Desk onboard.

Casino dealers and Lotus Spa personnel do not share in the Hotel and Dining charge as not all passengers utilize these services.

**BAR AND WINE CHARGE**

A 15% charge is automatically added to your bar charges and dining room wine account. This is shared amongst the beverage staff and their support staff, including cleaners and utility staff.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

This drill is a requirement of International Law.

## PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT



In the interest of energy conservation, your Stateroom Steward/Stewardess has been instructed to turn off all lights and to draw the sheers when you are out of your room. This will help in keeping a comfortable temperature within your stateroom during the daytime and will benefit the environment by reducing energy consumption.

Once you return to your stateroom, please adjust the lighting to your liking and open the sheers if you wish to enjoy the view. If you would prefer your Stateroom Steward/Stewardess to follow a different procedure to that detailed above, we would kindly ask you to instruct him/her accordingly.

## HYPODERMIC NEEDLES AND SYRINGES

Please contact your Stateroom Steward if you have a medical condition such as diabetes that requires the use of hypodermic needles or syringes. Your Stateroom Steward will provide a safe and proper waste receptacle.
